We need YOUR data!

Conducting our own Prevailing Wage Rate Survey is a boon to our industry. They prevent us from having to use wages from the DFW area or Davis-Bacon wages. The past few years, we have had abysmal responses from our members to our request for data.

Collecting this data is time consuming, but necessary for your firm and for our Chapter. We have a staff that is willing to take your data, and compile it, and help us maintain 'Central Texas' wages on Central Texas jobsites. This is one tool that will help us accurately portray the true "prevailing wages" in our 8 county catchment area.

We want to continue gathering wage rate information for the 01 April to 30 September 2016 time frame. Many folks find the Excel sheet easier to fill in, but if you wish to have paper forms, please simply print the forms found at www.CentexAGC.org/links

We are not asking you to report on *every* trade that you have. Here is a list of specific trades needed:

1. Please Complete the Form in its Entirety--General Contractors, please list subcontractors; Subcontractors, please give name of General Contractor.
2. Wage rate data furnished should be based on the "peak payroll period" (that period during which you had the largest number of employees) during the immediate past six months (April thru September of 2012).
3. Complete one survey form for each "job site" (just skip a few line in between each site) on which work was performed during the "peak payroll period". Please feel free to duplicate the form, or request additional forms from the Chapter Office (254.772.5400).
4. You may also download the cover letter, instructions and Excel forms (that can be printed) at www.CentexAGC.org/link
5. Wage rate data furnished should be on a "job site" basis on which work was performed during the "peak payroll period". *For example: If an employee worked on three (3) different job sites during the "peak payroll period", that employee should be reported three (3) times--once for each job site.*
6. Please indicate the COUNTY in which the work was performed because "Prevailing Wage Rates" are determined by counties.
7. Provide the number of employees per craft and hourly rate for each on the various projects worked during the "peak payroll period"--for example: Laborers: # 1 @ \$ 7.50; # 4 @ \$ 9.50; # 3 @ \$ 12.00; etc.
8. For Fringe Benefits, give the total amount of fringe benefits per employee per hour--for example: \$ 1.45/hour.
